Adhere to the culture of the organization together To manage energy in the organization for maximum efficiency According to energy saving measures as follows:

Measures to save electricity

1. Choose to use the air conditioner during 9:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m. by turning off the air conditioner during lunch break and before use 15–30 minutes and avoid activating multiple devices at the same time.
2. Set the air conditioner temperature at 25.–26 degrees Celsius
3. Clean the air filter once a month and clean the air conditioner twice a year.
4. Turn on the light as necessary and turn it off every time when not in use.
5. Unplug the hot water bottle once it is boiling and stop the habit of leaving it plugged in all day.
6. Fill the thermos with enough water for each use. And you should not add very cold water to the hot water bottle.
7. Unplug electrical equipment in the office such as computers and photocopiers. Fax machine Blown onto the table Every time when using
8. Turn off or set a timer to sleep on your computer screen. When not used for more than 15 minutes
9. Avoid using the elevator to go up and down only 1–2 floors

Water and fuel saving measures

1. Close the faucet tightly when not in use every time. As well as monitoring water leaks in the sanitary system and immediately notifying the person responsible for maintenance.

2. Avoid watering trees and lawns until they are flooded.

3. Keep the engine in ready-to-use condition and always study the route before setting off.
